



WORLD ARTS AND CULTURES Major

Fall 2018 - Change of Major Supplemental Application Worksheet

Students interested in the World Arts and Cultures major must identify themselves to the department **by 4:00pm on Friday, December 1, 2017** in order to participate in the department supplemental application process during Fall/Winter. Students are considered for admission in the following Spring or Fall quarters. The Department strongly prefers a minimum 3.0 GPA in World Arts and Cultures courses and an overall 2.0 GPA.

UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

You may apply to ONE major per quarter only.

You must be in good academic standing at the end of the application quarter. If you are on academic probation at the end of your previous quarter, you may still apply, with the expectation that your status will be cleared at the end of the current quarter. Minimum progress probation status may affect your change of major petition.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Students must be enrolled in at least one World Arts and Cultures course during the Fall quarter in which the petition is filed, so that their work may be monitored by the World Arts and Cultures/Dance faculty and counselor.

FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE APPLICANTS: You must have no more than 90 quarter units at the beginning of Winter Quarter, although fewer are recommended.

Applicants must have taken and/or be enrolled in at least two courses from: WAC 1, 20, 24, 33, a Preparation for the Major Elective Course (choose from 2, 22, M23, or 51W), 100A, or 100B

JUNIOR APPLICANTS: You must have no more than 120 quarter units at the beginning of Winter Quarter, although fewer are recommended. Competitive applicants will have the majority of their School and University requirements.

Applicants must have taken and/or be enrolled in at least five courses from: WAC 1, 20, 24, 33, a Preparation for the Major Elective Course (choose from 2, 22, M23, or 51W), 100A, or 100B

NOTE: Prospective students may be contacted to interview with department faculty during the review process to discuss specific details of their application.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

By **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2017 (4:00pm)**: Submit your UCLA Undergraduate Petition for Change of Major to the World Arts and Cultures/Dance Department Office (148D Kaufman Hall). Download the form here: <http://www.registrar.ucla.edu/Forms/Registration-and-Enrollment/Undergraduate-Program-Change-Petition>

Make sure to retain a copy of your petition form— you will need a PDF copy to upload into the online Change of Major registration.

Register your Change of Major at <https://supplemental.arts.ucla.edu/changeofmajor/>. This is the supplemental application site where you will upload your materials for the department, including your PDF copy of your petition. This site will open November 1.

Once you have registered, you will be able to begin your supplemental application at <https://supplemental.arts.ucla.edu/login.php>

By DECEMBER 15 (11:59pm PST): Submit your supplemental materials. *This is a strict deadline, please plan ahead to avoid any unexpected technical delays at the last minute.* Late, incomplete, or hard copy application material will not be considered.

Please turn off your email spam filter and/or include “arts.ucla.edu” and “ucla.edu” as accepted recipients.

Make sure you review all categories before you submit your supplemental application. You may log in/log out of the system as many times as needed during the filing period, but once the application is submitted, you will not be able to make **ANY** corrections or additions. You will receive an email confirmation within 24 hours after you have submitted your supplemental application. Students will be notified of departmental decisions via email after final grades and grade point averages for the current quarter have been calculated. Any updates to your academic record (i.e. grade changes, removal of incompletes, etc.) must be promptly reported to the department counselor.

Applicants are considered on a competitive basis. Admission into the World Arts and Cultures major is contingent upon enrollment availability in our major, as well as satisfactory completion of university and department requirements.

2. UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS (in PDF format)

Please upload a copy of your most current UCLA Degree Audit Report. If this is your first quarter at UCLA, an unofficial copy of your last college or high school transcript is also required.

All unofficial transcripts **MUST** be generated from their respective institutions, and must include the name of the institution as well as the student's full name. Please redact/black out your Social Security number.

3. PERSONAL STATEMENT

After reflecting upon the department's mission statement (<http://www.wacd.ucla.edu/about>), please explain what makes you an especially well-suited candidate for this BA program. Your response must reflect whether and how you see cultures and arts as tools for expression and social transformation.

You will have 3500 characters (including spaces) / approximately 500 words. We recommend that you write your statement in a separate word processing program, then cut and paste it into the web application.

4. RELATED TOPIC RESEARCH PAPER

A sample research paper that you have written for a class, demonstrating your critical thinking skills.

- 6-12 pages, double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12 point font
- At least **three (3)** external research sources (books, journals, films, etc.) that you have identified. Your reference list may count towards the total paper count.
- A cover sheet or abstract is optional. If you include a cover sheet and/or abstract, they will count towards the 12-page maximum.
- Place your full name and page number in the header of each page.
- Your paper may cover any topic that you see relates to the WAC BA. In this paper, faculty are looking to see how you select a research topic and present your analysis and critical thinking in relation to it.
- Write simply and clearly. A person who has no background in your subject matter, should be able to understand and appreciate your viewpoint.
